



On a scale of 1-5, 1 being completely clueless, 3 being generally informed, and 5 being completely informed, how would you rate your understanding of the primaries?




What is your party affiliation?



What is the MOST important issue for you in the election?




From Democrats & Independents\*: Which candidate would you support? (Based on events after the New Hampshire primary but before the Nevada caucuses)








